

CORONA GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS



TICKETING

By issuing online tickets only, we can also maintain an overview of visitor numbers at all times.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Because of the need for full registration and visitor control, there will be no combined tickets for ferry and catamaran for the special edition of INTERBOOT 2020. Online admission tickets and tickets for transport providers are therefore to be purchased separately.

As usual, the free Messe Express (MX line) will operate between the Hafen- und Stadtbahnhof (railway station) and the exhibition centre. Masks must be worn on public transport.



MINIMUM SOCIAL DISTANCING

All visitors are requested to observe minimum social distancing of 1.5 metres.

FULL REGISTRATION

All visitors must register online in advance. This ensures traceability in the event of a coronavirus infection. For this reason, in 2020 there will only be online tickets for the special edition of INTERBOOT.

MOUTH-AND-NOSE COVER

Please bring your own mouth-and-nose cover. Masks must be worn in enclosed spaces at the exhibition centre!

Exceptions:

- Seating with guaranteed minimum spacing of 1.5 metres
- When availing of restaurant/catering services
- Trade fair stands where individuals can observe minimum social distancing of 1.5 metres
- Where alternative protection for others of at least an equal standard is assured
- Mask intolerance confirmed by a doctor's certificate. Otherwise you have to wear a corona protection visor.

The provisions that currently apply are shown in the Messe Friedrichshafen's Protection and Hygiene Concept.

HYGIENE

You will find an adequate number of hand sanitiser dispensers throughout the exhibition centre, most notably at the entrances, hall intersections and the WC areas.

There will be shorter disinfection and cleaning intervals with regard to frequently touched surfaces such as doorknobs, handles, and surfaces in sanitary areas.

You are furthermore requested to dispense with the customary greeting rituals, and to observe sneezing and coughing etiquette.

INCREASED SPACE

We have increased hallway, traffic and activity spaces. By doing this we are giving visitors and exhibitors greater freedom of movement while guaranteeing the required social distancing.

VENTILATION

Entrance areas, exhibition halls, conference rooms and dining areas will be permanently supplied with fresh air (outdoor air quality).

ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION BAN

Entry to the exhibition centre will not be admitted to individuals who are or have been in contact with someone infected with the coronavirus where 14 days have not yet elapsed since the last contact. As well as for people who display the typical symptoms of coronavirus infection.
